
'Mukti Bhawan' wins big at Asian Academy Creative Awards

he multiple award-winning Indian drama film Mukti Bhawan/ Hotel Salvation will get the award under the category of BEST ORIGINAL SCREENPLAY for Shubhashish Bhutiani and Asad Hussain at the inaugural Asian Academy Creative Awards 2018(AAA'S) to be held this December in Singapore. There are 20 countries in contention for the awards across 49 categories. Mukti Bhawan is the sole feature film to be nominated for the final competition from India. The film has received over 30 Awards including two UNESCO, two National Awards and at festivals around the world.

Shubahshish who has written and directed *Mukti Bhawan* is elated at this honour, "It is heartening to be recognised on an international platform amongst some of the best work produced in Asia."
